

# Training

A parent of children under 18 dies every 22 minutes in the UK; around 23,600 a year. This equates to around 111 children being bereaved of a parent every day. Many more experience the death of a grandparent or other significant person.

The North Development Project team can offer twilight or inset sessions to schools – either when there has been a bereavement, or simply to raise awareness. We can also assist in the production of a School Bereavement Policy.

We can provide workplace bereavement training to help organisations and employers gain knowledge of how best to support staff and their families.

We can also discuss with you specific training that Child Bereavement UK offers at our dedicated centres and at other venues around the country.
